Examples may include:

- Page visits
- Traffic sources
- Popular content
- Error tracking
- Device/browser statistics

Providers may include analytics platforms such as Google Analytics or equivalent tools.

Functionality Cookies

These cookies remember choices you make and provide enhanced features.

Examples include:

- Language preference
- Region settings
- Accessibility settings
- Remembered form entries

Advertising or Targeting Cookies

If enabled in the future, these cookies may be used to deliver relevant communications or measure marketing effectiveness.

They may be set by advertising partners or social media platforms.

4. Third-Party Cookies

Some cookies may be placed by trusted third-party providers who assist us with hosting, analytics, security, embedded content or digital services.

We do not control third-party cookies directly. Their use is governed by their own privacy and cookie policies.

5. Managing Cookies

You can manage or disable cookies through your browser settings. Most browsers allow you to:

- View stored cookies
- Delete cookies
- Block cookies

- Clear browsing data
