# FITTING INSTRUCTIONS


## Step 1

Your ATV is equipped with rear winch mounting plate. If your ATV mounting plate is at an angle, like on the picture below, then use distance plate Pos.4 under the winch. This way the winch line will run correctly from under the winch and will not rub against ATV frame. Use supplied longer M8x35 bolts. On older type Outlander 6x6, with straight winch mounting plate, the distance plate is unnecessary and bolts supplied with winch should be used.




## Step 2

Install rollers to roller holder. NB! Before installing longer bottom roller, pass through the winch line. Use thread lock fluid on bolts!



## Step 3

Install assembled roller holder to ATV. NB! Use thread lock fluid on bolts!
