What will be studied	The course provides an overview of the history of EU finance, outlines the institutional and legislative framework for decision-making in the sector, explores sources of revenue, as well as EU programs and funds established for the period 2021-2027. The EU budget for the current year will serve as the main case for the analysis. As a final result of the course, we will try to reveal the links between the budgetary systems of the EU and its member states and extrapolate this to Ukraine's potential membership in the EU.	
Why it is interesting/should be studied	Ukraine's relations with the EU are becoming stronger and the presence of the EU in Ukraine and Ukraine in the EU is increasingly visible. Therefore, it is necessary and interesting to know about the advantages and disadvantages of cooperation with the EU in the budgetary and financial sphere.
