Requirements for Starting Studies	Basic knowledge of international relations, theory and practice of peacekeeping activities.
What will be Studied	History of the emergence and development of peacekeeping. Concept, principles, goals and main directions of peacekeeping. Modernization of the policy on modern peacekeeping and its current state. Strategy of Ukraine's participation in peacekeeping. Inconsistency of the military and police components of peacekeeping.
Why is it Interesting / should be Studied?	Since the beginning of its independence, Ukraine has been actively involved in peacekeeping operations, which today are not limited to the UN framework, but also include OSCE missions, activities within the framework of NATO's Partnership for Peace program, and multinational forces. Ukrainian peacekeeping forces are currently represented in nine international peacekeeping and security operations. Ukraine is the only country among NATO's Partner States that has participated in all major operations and missions of the Alliance.
What can you Learn (Learning Results)?	To know the nature of international peacekeeping cooperation, the nature of interaction between international actors. To understand the history and dynamics of international security, to analyze the features of its provision at the global, regional and

To investigate pressing problems of international relations, regional development, foreign policy of Ukraine, to present research results, to provide relevant recommendations. To analyze the features of peacekeeping activities (peacekeeping operations, missions) in support of peace of the UN, OSCE, activities within the framework of the NATO Partnership for Peace program and multinational forces, to classify them and analyze their effectiveness.</p>
