What will be studied	Peculiarities of the European vector development of Ukraine's foreign policy, the influence of the leader on the state's international relations establishment, the origin and escalation of international conflicts involving the Russian Federation and the strengthening of European support for Kyiv, the stages of the formation and development of the economic, political and security components of Ukraine's interstate relations with the EU and European states, the influence of sanctions and reduction of integration processes.
Why it is interesting / necessary to study	The study of the discipline contributes to the formation of students' scientific understanding of the essence and features of the integration processes in Europe, the European integration policy of Ukraine, as well as the study of all possible options for solving the problem of Ukrainian lands being under the temporary occupation of the Russian Federation.

What you can learn (learning outcomes)	Analyse the individual influence of the state political leader on the course of internal political and interstate processes; determine the specifics of the political institutions functioning (president, political parties, armed forces, elections, referendum) in Ukraine during the war; navigate the processes of regional integration, the causes of conflicts and military actions; investigate the essence of European integration, its prerequisites and factors; stages of Ukraine's European integration development, especially its contradictions and difficulties; prospects and consequences of modern European integration processes and Ukraine's place in them.
How to use the acquired knowledge and skills (competencies)	Analyse the essence of the international relations modern system; reveal the role of modern democratic processes in Europe; analyse the state and current problems of international security in Europe; understand the processes, prospects and consequences of the integration and disintegration processes of Ukraine; justify their views on Kyiv's European integration priorities and the prospects of the state's integration into European structures.
