POLICY OF THE SUBJECT	<p>All theoretical and practical tasks are handed in on the day of the seminar. Working students coordinate the schedule of assignments with the teacher. Missed classes are passed only if there is confirmation of a good reason for absence (certificate of absence due to illness or a statement about the need to miss classes).</p> <p>Module tests are not repeated.</p> <p>Cheating is prohibited.</p>
AIM AND TASKS OF THE SUBJECT	<p>The aim of the course is to examine the patterns of formation, functioning and changes in the international systems, actions and interactions of international systems of different levels and structures in specific manifestations in global development and in the context of modern global political process.</p> <p>The main objectives of the course are to train professionals capable of performing highly analytical, organizational, research and teaching work in the field of international relations and foreign policy activities.</p>
