2. COURSE SUMMARY

The program of the discipline "Second foreign language (German)" is compiled in accordance with the educational and vocational training program for bachelors of specialties: 291 – international relations, public communications and regional studies; 292 – international economic relations, educational programs of international relations, international economic relations, international information and public communications.

The subject of the course is oral and written speech, phonetic and grammatical features of modern German, knowledge of which makes it possible to form linguistic competence of students.

The program provides consistency and continuity in the study of the material during one year of study and is focused on the formation of skills and skills of practical knowledge of the German language.

The program is aimed at forming linguistic, communicative and linguistic competence among students. Linguistic competence includes knowledge of the language system and rules of its functioning in the process of communication; communication competence implies the ability to perceive and reproduce foreign speech in accordance with the terms of speech communication; linguo-regional knowledge includes knowledge about the main features of sociocultural development of the country in which the language is studied, as well as to be able to carry out its speech behavior in accordance with them The course study involves mastering:

- **Phonetic themes:** Long and short vowels. Longitude of vowels, their graphic designation. Transcription. Diftongs. Consonary sounds. Deaf and loud consoners. The concept of intonation. Intonational design of narrative and interrogative sentences. Verbal and phraseal stress. Phonetic phenomena. Assimilation and

hemination. Features of reading and pronouncing sounds in borrowed words. Study of edema, sayings, rhymes.

- **Grammatical themes:** Facial pronouns. The verb sein. Word order. Präsens weak verbs. Denial nicht, kein. Possessive pronouns. Cases in German. Numerals. Conjugation of nouns. Verb control. Separated and unsealed prefixes. The oral method of the verb. Prepositions from Dativ and Akkusativ. Dual control prepositions (Dativ and Akkusativ). Past talking time Perfekt. Future Time (Futurum I). Impersonal pronouns man and es. Prepositions from Genitiv. Adjective.

- **lexical topics:**

Vorstellungsgespräch. Die Familie. Wir lernen Fremdsprachen. Mein Arbeitstag. Mein Ruhetag. Freizeit und Urlaub. Die Wohnung. Das Haus. Die Jahreszeiten und das Wetter. Im Lebensmittelgeschäft. Mahlzeiten.

6. RECORDING SYSTEM AND ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

The current control is 40% of the amount of points paid for the evaluation of this module and in general is 40 points for the scoring loan.

The current assessment consists of the total number of points: - assessment during practical classes (SOFTWARE) (the maximum score in one lesson "5", and the current content module is defined as arithmetic mean);
- evaluation of self-performed work of students (CP) – 5 points.

Modular test works (ICDs) are determined in points according to the results of control and are 60 points: 20 points for each of the two written modules, as well as the final test work, which is evaluated at 20 points, and includes 10 tasks for checking and studying lexical material, 10 for grammar control.

In the first semester, the form of control is scoring.

The test is set if the student has completed all types of educational work, which are determined by the program of the discipline and received at least 60 points. In case of unsatisfactory final evaluation, or if you want to increase the rating, the student can get points on the test by performing a certain type of work. The total amount of points for the course is 100. The assessment for the development of the course is set according to the assessment scale.

In the second semester, the final control takes place in the form of an exam, for which a student can get a maximum of 60 points. The student necessarily takes the exam in the event that he scored less than 75 points during the semester, or if he does not agree with the points that he scored. In this case, the points for modular control works are canceled, points for the current evaluation remain. The total amount of points for the course is 100. The assessment for the development of the course is set according to the assessment scale.
