III. DESCRIPTION OF THE EDUCATIONAL COMPONENT

1. Summary.

The educational component is designed to acquaint students with the conceptual apparatus, essence and features of information and analytical activities in the field of international business. The acquired knowledge and skills can be used in practical activities and are necessary for the formation of a highly qualified specialist in the field of international economic relations and international business in particular.

2. Prerequisites: knowledge of the basics of the theory of international economic relations, information technologies in international relations, international information and public communications, the world economy and world markets, the organization and conduct of international business, mathematics for economists and economic modelling.

3. Purpose and tasks of the educational component.

The general goal of the course "Information and analytical activities in international business" is to form students' theoretical knowledge about the order of organization and conducting information and analytical activities in the field of international business, as well as to develop practical skills in collection and use of information, to stady and master the methodology of modern analysis in international business. The educational component is oriented to form students' comprehensive vision of methodology, modern trends and current problems of information and analytical activities in international business. However, the educational component is also aimed at the development of certain skills, such as critical thinking, integration of knowledge on different topics, awareness and openness to current initiatives in the economy.

4. Learning outcomes (competencies).

Special (professional) competencies:

- FC1. Ability to identify the characteristic features and trends in the development of the world economy, features of the implementation of economic policy and world integration/disintegration processes, including Euro-Atlantic integration.
- FC2. Ability to use basic categories and the latest theories, concepts, technologies and methods in the field of international economic relations, taking into account their main forms, to apply theoretical knowledge on the functioning and development of international economic relations.
- FC3. Ability to identify the peculiarities of the functioning of the environment of international economic relations and models of economic development.
- FC4. Ability to substantiate the peculiarities of the implementation of forms of international economic relations at the mega-, macro-, meso- and micro-levels.

Control methods*: DS – discussion, DB – debate, T – tests, TR – training, RZ / K – solving problems / cases, INDS / IRS – individual task / individual work of the applicant for education, RMG – work in small groups, MKR / KR – modular test paper / test, P – abstract, as well as analytical note, analytical essay, analysis of the work, etc.

6. INDS.

The conducting of the INDS consists in the implementation and presentation of the results of the analysis of the enterprise activities (chosen by the student), using basic tools and techniques of information and analytical activities in the field of international business (topic 3).

IV. ASSESSMENT POLICY

Attending seminars is a mandatory component of the assessment, for which points are awarded. Missed seminars can be worked out as an individual assignments if there is a reasonable excuse for the missing class. Students who miss seminars without a weighty reason get lower points.

Also, the student has the right to the recognition of learning outcomes obtained in formal, non-formal and/or informal education (https://cutt.ly/9wPgvTK1).

Students must adhere to the principles of academic integrity.

All forms of cheating – on the credit, homework, assignments, control work – are unacceptable.

V. FINAL CONTROL

For each topic of the content module, that are discussed/presented at the seminars the student can get some points as it is given in the table above.

In case of *exam* the maximum number of points for studying the course is 100, including:

- up to 40 points for participation in discussions (seminars);
- up to 60 points for the final module control (exam).

A student who scores more than 75 points before the exam can agree to credit these points as the final grade for the course (without passing the exam). Students who score less than 75 points or want to improve their final grade for the course take the exam at the time specified in the schedule of the test and examination session. The exam is conducted in oral form. The required minimum for successful completion of the course is 60 points (see the Regulations on the current and final assessment of knowledge at Lesya Ukrainka VNU – https://vnu.edu.ua/sites/default/files/2023-09/2023_Polozh_pro_otzin.pdf).
